We strive to provide a system of care for the students and families of the Raymore-Peculiar School District by meeting physical, emotional, and social needs that allow our students and families to live successful and meaningful lives.

CAN:

Caring About Nutrition provides healthy and child-friendly food for students on weekends throughout the year. Every week volunteers sort and log donations before pulling items for that week's bags. Each Thursday, a group of volunteers pack the food, and other volunteers distribute it to our schools.

Panther Closet:

Gently used and new clothes and hygiene items are collected for distribution to families in need within the school district. The closet is housed at Raymore Elementary. Good Neighbor, Strong Community Education Initiative:

This is a community education initiative centered on developing and enhancing the skills and actions needed to be good neighbors and build a strong community

This relationship is a joint effort led by the school and partner and supported by the Raymore-Peculiar School District.

Requests submitted through CarePortal come from caseworkers at government child welfare agencies or other child-serving organizations approved by CarePortal to vet needs.
